


Get to know your

MED-EL RONDO 3 Speech Processor





The processor goes on the charging unit with the flat side facing upwards. The orange light will come on to indicate that the device is charging. It will go off once it is fully charged (after approximately 4 hours).

MED-EL Fine Tuner Echo



- Volume Increase or decrease volume
- Sensitivity Increase or decrease audio sensitivity
- Programme Selection Choose a programme
- Operault Set volume and audio sensitivity to default setting as determined by your audiologist
- AudioLink Activate or deactivate connection with AudioLink.
- 6 Keyped Lock Press for several seconds to lock or unlock the keyped.
- Processor Selection Select left, right, or both audio processors
- Please note, for RONDO 3 the MT button has a monitoring mode function only.

TOP TIPS

- If you have a new or replacement processor, you will need to pair it with the fine tuner echo. To do this, place the processor on the back of the fine tuner and switch the processor off and back on again. To pair two processors to one fine tuner, repeat the above step with your second processor.
- The battery in the fine tuner should last for a long time. We do keep spares so please request one if your battery does run out.
- For bilateral users, decide which processor(s) you wish to change and push the appropriate button on the bottom row before pushing a different button(s).
